KEYPERSON

Do you know who your child's Keyperson is? Every child in Abercromby is assigned to one of the Nursery staff as their "Keyperson", or special grown up. A Keyperson is someone your child will form a special bond with, who will get to know your child really well, make observations about your child's learning, assess how they are doing and plan next steps for learning for them. There is a display up in each room to show who your child is with, and if you're not sure just ask. This is also shown on our Info TV in the entrance hall. After the Half Term holiday, we will be setting up some days where you can make an appointment with your Keyperson to talk about how your child is doing.

NURSERY SPACES

At the start of the year we always have spaces, as many of our children have moved onto Reception classes in Primary schools. Do you know anyone with a child who is 3 or 4 and would like to come and join the fun at Abercromby? We know that word of mouth is the most powerful advertisement!

WONDERFUL LEARNING!

We've only been back a few weeks but already there is been fantastic learning taking place! The children were so excited when they went into the garden for the first time after the Summer holidays and saw all the fruit on the trees. They wandered around picking the fruit and eating it, their cheeks were full like hamsters! I thought the plums especially, were the tastiest I've ever eaten!
