- WE CANNOT MAKE IT “NO RISK”, BUT WE CAN MAKE IT “LOW RISK”

Please do not bring your child into school if you or your family have symptoms of Covid-19:

- A fever
- A new persistent cough
- A loss or change in sense of smell and/or taste



If your child or anyone in your family has symptoms of Coronavirus, please get a test and let us know the result, positive or negative.



- Only one adult can come in with your child and it's best if it's the same adult every time
- Both you and your child should wear clean clothes every day
- Please don't allow your child to bring in any toys from home
- Please wear a face covering whilst you are in the Nursery - we can supply a mask if necessary.
- Your child does not need to wear a mask
- We will take your details for the Track and Trace system
- Please do not use our staff toilets, unless it is an absolute emergency



- You will be asked to clean your hands with alcohol gel as you enter Reception
- Once in the classroom, please wash your hands and your child's hands for 20s with soap and water, then drying them with a paper towel.
- Do this before leaving school as well.
- Please catch any coughs and sneezes with a tissue and place them in the bin, washing hands for 20s afterwards



- Please keep a strict 2m social distance from the staff and all other children.
- Please do not touch anything in the Nursery.
- As much as possible, we ask you to wait outside in the garden, whilst the staff will play with your child inside or outside, wherever he/she chooses.
- We will work towards your child staying by themselves as soon as possible, aiming for you to leave him/her at the outside classroom door
